Prayerfully reflect on the blessings God has entrusted to you and the legacy of faith and generosity you hope to leave.

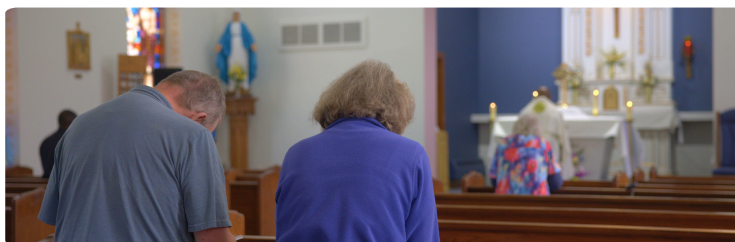
GRATITUDE
